As we all are well aware of the past Easter attack which assisted a rapid increase in racial issues in our country, we as the next generation has to do something to stop racial prejudice. As a precaution we must first pamper the passion of being an anti-racist and that is our main goal. By conducting this contest we are trying our greatest to spotlight the ideas of our young sisters about this incident and how we can ourselves contribute in this by putting an end to racism in Sri Lanka.

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Methodology:

The participants are given the topic "**End to Hometown Racism**" where they can either write a paragraph of 100-150 words or do a short video clip of maximum 2 minutes. We plan to hold this competition in two categories as junior and senior in which the junior category includes from grades 6 to 8 and the senior category includes from grades 9 to 13. All participants must send their video or the writings to the email dbvmun@gmail.com. The winners are to be announced through the school website.

Rules and Regulations:

- The motivational video and writing contest is held separately in two categories as junior and senior and the junior category includes grades from 6 to 8 whereas the senior category includes grades 9 to 13.
- The participants are expected to write a paragraph of 100-150 words or do a short video clip of maximum 2 minutes.
- The deadline for all participants will be 30th of June and they are expected to send the writings and the short video clips on or before the due date.
- They are not allowed to paraphrase any of the existing documents and doing that will cause immediate disqualification from the contest.
- The final videos and the paragraphs must be sent to the email address provided in the school website.
- Participants are allowed to use either English or Sinhala medium.
- The winning videos will be proclaimed in the school website and the paragraphs will be unveiled.
- The winners will be announced in the school website and will be informed privately through the provided email addresses.
- The participants are requested to include all the required personal information in the data sheet provided to them and not including the particulars will cause invalidation.
- The participants are kindly requested to send the documents before the deadline mentioned in the school website.
- Participation in the contest implies that participants accept the integrality of these rules. Non-compliance with the rules results in the automatic cancelation of the participation in the contest.
