### "Handmade greeting cards competition"

1. This competition is open for the students of grade 6 and 7.
  - Individual participation
  - Card should be made by the student herself only.
2. Competitors can make only one greeting card and email the photo of it on or before the deadline, to the email address given below.
3. Relevant themes for making greeting cards :
  - New year
  - Vesak
  - Christmas
  - Get well
  - Congratulations
  - Thank you etc.



When the school starts, the greeting cards should be handed over to the school.

4. Size of the card should be A4 board size. Competitors can use natural materials/paper/cloth etc. Mention your name and the class on the bottom right corner.
5. Judgement will be based on the theme, creativity, neatness and artistic work done by the student.
6. The decision of the judges will be final.

In many countries, books, comics, magazines, newspapers and even posters are rare commodities and the classroom environment is the ideal place where children will come into contact with words in the written form.

### Book Cover Design Contest Rules and Regulations

1. Eligible participants are the students of grade 8.
2. Two categories based on the medium used
  - Drawings, Collage  
If this is selected, all possible techniques can be used to do the drawings, separately or mixed: coloured felt pens, paint, markers, colour pencils, pastel, etc.
  - Technological Designs  
If you use the Book Cover template, colour it with your own amazing design. The template can be copied or reproduced on a separate sheet of paper.
3. All artwork must be original to the artist who is entering; an adaptation of existing artwork is not acceptable.
4. Competitors are permitted to enter **one (1)** original design.
5. Artwork must display the title of the book, 'Creations'.
6. No design is to be larger than B5
7. The drawings should be scanned and sent on or before the deadline.

## Inter House English Drama Script Writing Competition 2020



- The Drama Script Writing competition is open to all the students (Grade 6-13) representing all four Houses in the school.
- The competition requires students to write a drama script based on the given topic / theme under each category. Each House must submit two (2) drama scripts (Junior and Senior).
- Scripts must be the original work of the student(s). Only original scripts are eligible for awards. Using Scripts that have been previously published or any other source material written by another author are not eligible under any circumstances.
- Once a script has been entered in the competition, under no circumstances will we accept substitutions of new drafts or corrected pages.
- Material should be submitted in standard format, font, spacing and margin.
- Submissions are accepted via electronic submission only. Any script submitted after the Final Entry Deadline will be disqualified.

### Script Guidelines and Rules

- Drama scripts should be formatted in Word (as a PDF) on A4 size paper with a standard 12pt font, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing and margins (top/bottom: 2.5cm; left/right: 3.0 cm).
- Cover page and the Cast of Characters page will not be counted to the number of pages.
- The name of the House should appear in the cover page and all pages should be numbered.
- The judges will focus primarily on the use of language, setting, scenes, characters, use of dramatic techniques and interpretation of the story.
- Adding a better topic and a song (originally written by a student) will score more marks to the script

Decisions of the Judges are final and may not be disputed.
